Cơm Tấm (Broken Rice) – A Southern Treat

Cơm Tấm, or broken rice, is one of the most famous dishes in Southern Vietnam, especially in Ho Chi Minh City. Unlike regular rice, Cơm Tấm uses rice grains that are fractured during the milling process, giving it a unique texture. The most common and classic version is served with grilled pork chop (sườn nướng) that is marinated with lemongrass and fish sauce. The dish is usually topped with a thin omelet (trứng ốp la), shredded pork skin (bì), and a spoonful of sweet and sour fish sauce (nước chấm). It is often enjoyed for breakfast or lunch because it is quick to prepare and very filling. The mixture of savory meat, smooth egg, and a rich sauce creates an unforgettable flavour.
