The diphthongs **ou** and **ow** can make the /ou/ sound, as in without and towns.

The letters **ow** can also be a vowel pair making the /ō/ sound, as in hollow.

The letters **ou** can make the /ō/ sound in although, the /ô/ sound in thought, or the /u/ sound, as in southern.
