

We repeat the verb **was** or **were** in the short answer:


Yes, I **was**. / No, I **wasn't**.

Had is the past simple form of **have**. We use **had** to talk about something that belonged to someone in the past, or something that they did in the past.



We use **didn't (have)** to make the negative form.

didn't = did not

Affirmative

Negative

He **had** an ice cream.

She **didn't have** a sandwich.

We **had** a lot of fun on vacation.

I **didn't have** any homework.

We can ask yes/no questions about the past with **Did + subject pronoun + base form of the verb.**

Questions

Did you **have** a good day?

Short answers

Yes, I **did**. / No, I **didn't**.

Did they **have** lunch at the beach?

Yes, they **did**. / No, they **didn't**.


