





To make the negative past simple, we use **didn't** + base form of the verb.

Affirmative

They **lived** a long time ago.

He **wanted** fruit for breakfast.

Questions

To ask yes/no questions about the past with regular verbs, we can use **Did** + subject pronoun + base form of the verb.

Did you **start** your homework?

Did they **finish** the cake?

Negative

She **didn't live** in a house.

I **didn't want** to go home.

Short answers

Yes, I **did**. / No, I **didn't**.

Yes, they **did**. / No, they **didn't**.






