



Nouns can be countable or uncountable. Countable nouns are things that you can count. Uncountable nouns are things that you cannot count.

We use **a**, **an**, or **one** before a singular countable noun.  
**an onion**, **a mushroom**, **one melon**

We can use numbers or **some** before plural countable nouns.  
**three onions**, **two mushrooms**, **some melons**.

We use **some** before uncountable nouns.  
Uncountable nouns don't have a plural form. We don't use **a** or **an**.  
**some iced tea**, **some meat**

We can use **that** before any noun.  
*I'd like **that** melon.*
