### Online games – bringing people together

Ryan isn't the only person to invite online friends to his wedding. There are other stories about online friends going to each other's weddings. There are also stories about gamers who travel across a country to visit an online friend in hospital, or online friends from different countries who meet up after ten years or more of playing together.
