

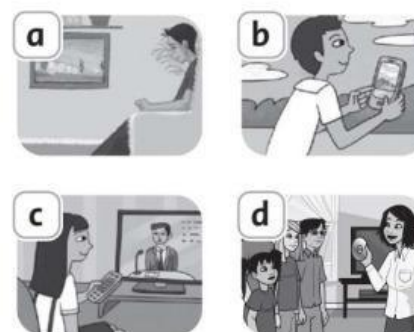

We use **be going to** + verb to talk about a future plan.

Affirmative

I'm going to play a video game.

They're going to watch a TV show.

Negative

I'm not going to watch TV.

They're not going to cook dinner.

We can use **be** + subject pronoun + **going to** to ask yes/no questions about the future.

Are you going to go to the party? Yes I am. / No, I'm not.

Is she going to take a photo? Yes, she is. No, she isn't.

We can ask open questions about the future with **what** and **where** and **be going to**.

What are you going to do?

Where are you going to go?

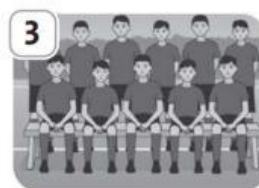
