<p>Noun</p> <p><i>A noun is a name — a person, place, thing, or idea.</i></p> <p>Examples: Sara, dog, school, happiness</p> <p>Remember: <i>If you can put “the/a/an” before it → it’s probably a noun.</i></p>	<p>Verb</p> <p><i>A verb shows action or being.</i></p> <p>Examples: run, dance, shout, is, are</p> <p>Remember: <i>If you can do it, or if it tells what something is → it’s a verb.</i></p>
<p>Pronoun</p> <p><i>A pronoun takes the place of a noun. Examples:</i> he, she, it, they, you</p> <p>Remember: <i>Pronouns stop us from repeating names over and over.</i></p>	<p>Adjective</p> <p><i>An adjective describes a noun.</i></p> <p>Tells: What kind? Which one? How many? Examples: red ball, two cats, happy girl Remember: <i>Adjectives add color and detail to nouns.</i></p>
<p>Adverb</p> <p><i>An adverb describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb.</i></p> <p>Tells : how, when, where, how much</p> <p>Examples: run quickly, very tall, arrive early Remember: <i>Lots end in -ly but not all!</i></p>	<p>Conjunction</p> <p><i>A conjunction joins words, phrases, or sentences.</i></p> <p>Examples: and, but, or, because, although Remember: <i>Think of them as “word glue”</i></p>
<p>Preposition</p> <p><i>A preposition shows a relationship-> usually location, time, or direction.</i></p> <p>Examples: in, on, at, under, before, with</p> <p>Remember: <i>Often tells where something is.</i></p>	<p>Interjection</p> <p><i>An interjection shows strong feeling. Examples:</i> Wow! Oh no! Hey!</p> <p>Remember: <i>Usually followed by an exclamation mark.</i></p>
