It's hard to believe but, before the Internet, students weren't able to look at millions of pages of information in their own homes. They used to do research in libraries. Now, anyone with a computer and Internet can simply log on and find what they need. However there can be problems using the Internet.

How do you find what you want?

There is a lot of information on the Internet. Here are some tips for a successful research: think carefully about what you want to find; choose a search engine like Google or Yahoo; type in just the key words and remember that you can restrict your search by putting quotation marks around phrases.

How can you check if the information is correct?

Anyone can write a website so don't believe everything you read. It is important to check facts in different websites; only use pages you trust and learn to see the difference between facts and opinions.

Avoid cheating

It's easy to cut and paste information but it's dishonest. Don't just change one or two words- it's still cheating!, use the information to make your own notes, then use your notes to write your project.
