The **Komodo Dragon** (*Varanus komodoensis*) is the largest species of lizard, growing to a maximum length of 3 meters (10 feet) and weighing up to 70 kilograms (150 lb). They are endemic to the Indonesian islands of Komodo, Rinca, Flores, and Gili Motang.

Komodo Dragons have a distinctive appearance: a massive, muscular body, a long, powerful tail, and short, sturdy legs. Their skin is rough and durable, covered in tiny, osteoderm scales that act like chain mail. They are typically dark green or grey, blending well with their dry, rugged habitat.

These creatures are apex predators in their ecosystem. They are carnivorous and will eat almost any kind of meat, including large prey like water buffalo, deer, and pigs, which they typically ambush. Although they appear slow, Komodo Dragons can run briefly at speeds up to 20 km/h (12 mph). They also possess venom glands that produce toxins, contributing to the death of their prey. They use their strong sense of smell, relying on their long, forked tongue to detect carrion from several kilometers away.

Komodo Dragons are solitary animals, meeting only to breed or to eat. Due to poaching and habitat loss, they are classified as **Endangered**. Conservation efforts are vital to protect these magnificent reptiles in their natural environment.
