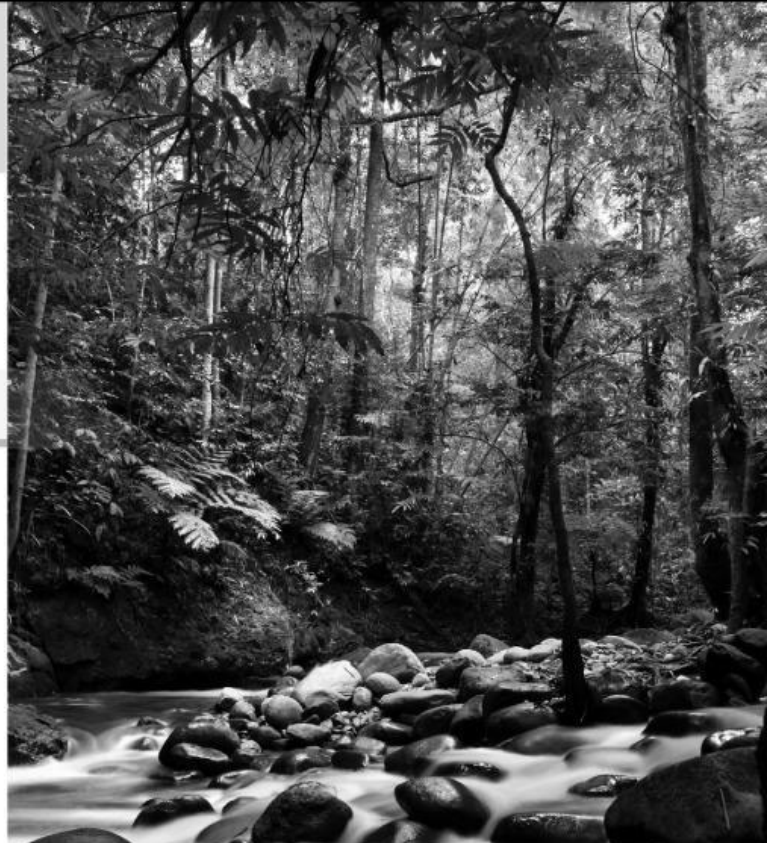

Amazing Rainforests

Rainforests are amazing. They are huge areas of very tall, very green trees **1** grow close to one another. Many of these trees can measure 130 metres high, and some even **2** 200 metres. Tropical rainforests have more kinds of trees than any other forests in the world. They are near the equator, where the sun is very strong, **3** they get lots of sunlight and warmth. But, they are also very wet places; they usually have more than two metres of rainfall every year.

The rainforests are home to more than half of the world's animal species, some of which are very **4**. Unfortunately, some species have become extinct and many more are **5**. This is because of deforestation, which is the cutting down of trees in an area. Sadly, as people continue to cut down trees, more species will die out as some of these animals can only survive in their natural **6**. Deforestation can also cause droughts. **7** trees are cut down, less water goes into the atmosphere and there is less rainfall which sometimes leads to drought. Some rainforests, including the Amazon, have already started having droughts because so many rainforest trees have **8** cut down.



Unfortunately, these amazing rainforests are disappearing very quickly. Environmental groups are trying to stop the deforestation, but it isn't **9** easy task. Governments around the world **10** to find a solution to protect the rainforests. They are very important in so many ways that they must survive.
