
Bony structures forming the framework of the mouth and containing the teeth.

All About Dinosaurs


Reading and Comprehension Questions

Stegosaurus were large dinosaurs that only ate plants. They were very big but their brains were the same size as a dog's.





Tyrannosaurus Rex were also very big dinosaurs. They ate other dinosaurs and could even crush their bones!
