The teeth and the stomach are important parts of the body. Each has its own function.

The teeth are the first tools used in digestion. They crush and grind food to make it into bolus. Digestion begins when the bolus is mixed with saliva. When swallowed, the food passes through the gullet and into the stomach where it is further broken down.

The final stage of digestion takes place in the small intestine where the food is also absorbed by the body. The unused portion is finally taken to the large intestine and then excreted.
