

Describing Clothes + Preferences & Comparatives

Asking about preferences

One and ones are used to avoid repeating a noun that was already mentioned. They help you speak more naturally without repeating words.

One = singular → I like the red shirt, but I prefer the blue **one**.

Ones = plural → which shoes do you like? The black **ones**.

Which dress do you prefer?

I prefer the blue one.

Which one do you like more?

I like the blue one more

Comparative Adjectives

Comparatives are adjectives we use to compare two things. They show that something is more or less than something else.

One-syllable adjectives (Add **-er + than**)

cheap → cheaper than
nice → nicer than
big → bigger than
tall → taller than

Example: The blue dress is nicer than the black one.

Two syllables ending in **-y (y → i + -er)**

pretty → prettier than
easy → easier than
happy → happier than

Example: This skirt is prettier than the red one.

Long adjectives (two or more syllables) → **more + adjective + than**

comfortable → more comfortable than
expensive → more expensive than
stylish → more stylish than

Example: The black dress is more stylish than the blue one.
