Avere, Essere, & Fare are irregular verbs so they are not conjugated the same way as the other verbs. It is incredibly important that you know ALL of the forms of these verbs as they will be heavily used in your Italian careers :)

AVERE: to have

	You have		You all have
	He/She has		They have

ESSERE: to be

	I am		We are
	You are		You all are
	He/She is		They are

FARE: to do/make

	I do/make		We do/make
	You do/make		You all do/make
	He/She does/makes		They do/make
