

Present Simple

We use the **present simple** to talk about **routines, habits, preferences, and facts.**



Affirmative sentences:

- I **like** music.
- We **watch** movies.
- She **likes** TV series.
- He **watches** TV at night.

Important: With **he / she / it**, we add **-s** to the verb in affirmative sentences.

Negative sentences: To make negative sentences, we use **do not (don't)** or **does not (doesn't)**.

- I **don't like** horror movies.
- We **don't like** reality shows.
- He **doesn't like** action movies.
- She **doesn't like** that series.

Yes / No questions: To ask questions, we use **Do** or **Does** at the beginning of the sentence.

- **Do** you like pop music?
- **Do** they like comedy movies?
- **Does** he like TV?
- **Does** she like romantic series?

Short answers: - **Yes, I do.** / **No, I don't.** - **Yes, he does.** / **No, he doesn't.**

Object Pronouns: Object pronouns replace nouns and come **after the verb.**

Subject Object

I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
we	us
they	them

My favorite movies

My name is Laura. I like movies a lot. My favorite movies are action and comedy movies. I like Tom Holland and Emma Stone. I watch them every weekend. Tom Holland is my favorite actor and I love him. I don't like horror movies. I don't watch them because they are scary.

- Examples:** - I like this **song** → I like **it**.
- She loves **movies** → She loves **them**.
 - He doesn't like **María** → He doesn't like **her**.
