The future of tourism?

What is a tourist? According to tourism experts, a tourist is a person who travels to another country or another part of their own country. They usually travel by train or plane or car. They usually stay away from home for at least one night. But the most important thing is that they go for fun or because they are interested in something in that place, like the architecture of historic buildings or the beauty of the peaceful countryside.

But what will a tourist be in the future? A scientist wrote an interesting article about tourism recently. She said that one day, tourists might stop traveling to places the way we do now. She explained that all travel was a bad thing for the planet and that international travel by plane was the worst, with international travel by ship a close second.

Instead of really visiting places, she said that tourists would visit places using something called virtual reality, or VR for short. VR is like a computer game that feels very real. You can see, hear, and sometimes even touch things in VR. So, instead of tourists getting on planes or ships to see interesting places, **they** would come to you in your own home.

This change could have a big effect on tourist spots. Famous buildings, natural wonders, or beaches might not have as many visitors. This could be good to save the places. But it could also be bad, because many people living in these places make some or all of their money every year from tourists. But perhaps local people in tourist areas could get together and create VR tours of their locations and sell them online.

So, in the future, VR tourism could **protect** places, while tourism at the moment is often doing the opposite.
