Living language

Experts say that there are now about 6,000 languages in the world. The five with most speakers are Mandarin Chinese, English, Spanish, Arabic and Hindi. However, some languages are dying. Twenty years ago, 1,000 languages became extinct and there are 500 more in danger of extinction. This means that only a few people are speaking the language.

Only a few thousand people now speak Choctaw, the language of the Choctaw Indians of North America. The Choctaw people are trying to preserve their language and traditions, so language classes are available on-line!

Languages also change. When we communicate with people from other countries, we learn new words and we can learn to speak better. In English, there are words from over 120 different languages. *Pizza* and *pasta*, for example, are Italian words, *mosquito* is a Spanish word, and *piranha* is from Brazilian Portuguese. People travel, and languages travel too!
