A (1) new museum has opened in Egypt's capital city, Cairo. The Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM) held an inauguration ceremony on Saturday attended by a (2) of dignitaries including kings and heads of (3). Egypt's President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi said GEM "is (4) to become an international cultural and scientific (5), contributing to enhancing tourism promotion in Egypt".
