Where <b>is</b> he <b>from</b> ?	(He's <b>from</b> Canada.)
<b>Are</b> you <b>from</b> Korea?	(Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.)
<b>Is</b> she <b>from</b> São Paulo?	(Yes, she is. / No, she's not. OR No, she isn't.)

Where is → **Where's**  
Where are NOT ~~Where're~~

**Be careful!**  
Are you from Japan?  
Yes, I am. NOT Yes, ~~I am from.~~
