Vietnamese food culture **varies** by regions from the north to the south. In Northern Vietnam, food is characterized by light and balanced flavors. Northern Vietnam is considered the origin of Vietnamese cuisine with many notable dishes like Pho, Bun Rieu, Bun Thang, Bun Cha, Banh Cuon, etc. Then, food culture in Northern Vietnam became popular in Central and Southern Vietnam with suitable flavors in each region.

Food in this region is often cooked with chili peppers and shrimp sauces, creating strong and rich flavors. Some well-known dishes include Bun Bo Hue, Banh Khoai, and Banh Beo.

In Southern Vietnam, the warm weather and fertile soil create ideal conditions for planting a variety of fruits, vegetables and livestock. Thus, food in the region is often added with garlic, shallots and fresh herbs. Particularly, Southerners are fond of sugar; they add sugar in almost dishes. Some signature dishes from Southern Vietnam include Banh Khot and Bun Mam.
