Example:

Do you work on weekends?

Yes, I do.

Wh-questions

Structure

Wh-word + do/does + subject + infinitive verb + complement + ?

Example

What **do** you do in the morning?

Remember

The first "do" in these sentences works as an auxiliary verb only.

Wh-words: how, why, when, where, what, which.

Tom: No, I don't. I read a book and go to bed early.
