A. THEORY

I. GRAMMAR

❖ **Prepositions of direction & position** (Giới từ / cụm chỉ phương hướng và vị trí)

- **Cách dùng:** để chỉ hướng đi khi di chuyển hoặc chỉ vị trí của một nơi/sự vật.

- **Dấu hiệu nhận biết:**

+ đi với động từ chỉ chuyển động (go, walk, run, move, turn...) → chỉ hướng đi.

+ đi với động từ be (is/are), on the left / on the right → chỉ vị trí.

Preposition	Meaning	Example
from	từ (điểm bắt đầu)	She walks from the bus stop.
to	đến	We go to the museum.
towards	về phía	Walk towards the park.
across	băng qua	He runs across the road.
up	lên / dọc lên	Go up the street.
on the left	bên trái	The bank is on the left.
on the right	bên phải	The post office is on the right.

❖ **Usages of get** (Các cách sử dụng của động từ get)

Usage	Example
nói đến việc đến nơi nào đó	We get to school by bus.
sự thay đổi về cảm xúc hoặc tình huống	Do you get nervous during exams? The weather gets cold in winter.

2. Method: Skimming & Scanning

- Đọc lướt (Skimming):

- + Đọc **tiêu đề, câu đầu và câu cuối** của mỗi đoạn.
- + Chú ý các **từ khóa chính** (danh từ, động từ, tính từ, trạng từ, từ để hỏi).
- + Xác định ý **chính** của đoạn/bài đọc.

- Đọc quét nhanh (Scanning):

- + Gạch chân **từ khóa trong câu hỏi** (ai, cái gì, ở đâu, khi nào...).
- + Lướt nhanh bài đọc, tìm **từ/cụm từ trùng hoặc gần giống** từ khóa.
- + Đọc kỹ câu chứa từ khóa, **đối chiếu** với câu hỏi để chọn đáp án.

Ví dụ: Câu hỏi: **1. Whose teacher asked the class to make a boat from different things?**

- Đọc lướt (Skimming):

- + **Tiêu đề/nhân vật:** Astrid → đoạn này nói về **hoạt động của lớp Astrid**.
- + **Ý chính:** Đoạn văn kể rằng giáo viên công nghệ của Astrid **hướng dẫn cách làm thuyền**, sau đó **yêu cầu cả lớp làm mô hình thuyền từ nhiều vật liệu** khác nhau và quay video giải thích.
→ Giáo viên của Astrid yêu cầu học sinh làm thuyền bằng nhiều loại vật liệu.

- Đọc quét nhanh (Scanning):

- + **Từ khóa trong câu hỏi:** teacher, asked, make a boat, different things.
- + **Câu quan trọng:** “Then she told us to make a model of a ship using wood, plastic and metal.”
- + **Đối chiếu & kết luận:** make a model of a ship → **làm thuyền**
using wood, plastic and metal → từ **nhiều vật liệu** khác nhau

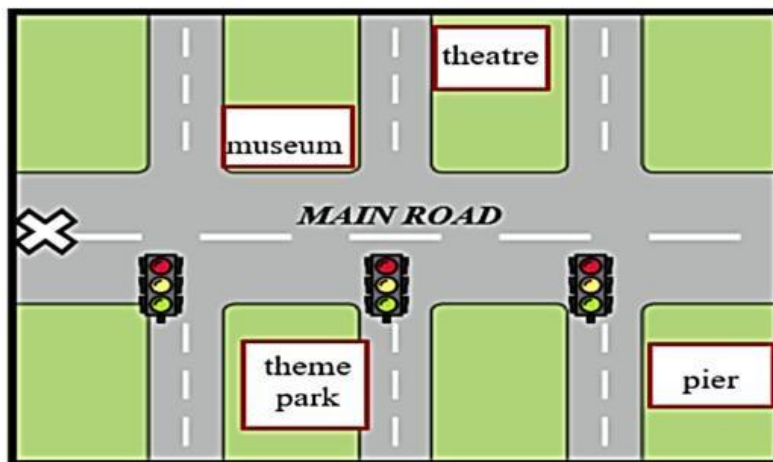
Kumiko
