
Choose a theme and topic you want to be a report text.

Group	Topic	Scenario	Example topic
1.	Rare Animal	Your group will act as a team of animal researchers tasked with creating a simple scientific report on rare animals. The information presented must be based on facts from reliable sources.	Komodo dragon, Orangutan, Sumatran tiger, Sea turtle, etc.
2.	Natural Phenomena	Your group acts as a natural disaster education team that explains natural phenomena scientifically so that they are easy for the community to understand.	Volcanoes, Earthquakes, Landslides, Tsunamis, Floods, etc.
3.	Rare Plants	Your group will act as botanical researchers who report scientific facts about rare plants to other students.	Rafflesia, Venus Flytrap, Cactus, Bamboo, etc.
4.	The Human Body	Your group will act as a health team that creates a factual report about parts of the human body.	Heart, Lungs, Brain, Digestive System, etc.
5.	Technology in everyday life	Your group acts as a technology team that develops and explains a technology objectively and factually.	Handphone, Internet, Artificial Intelligence, Media social, etc.
6.	Natural foods and beverages	Your group acts as a food education team that explains natural foods or beverages scientifically.	Honey, Milk, Rice, Coffee Beans, Tea Leaves, etc.


