Traveling the world means you get the chance to see interesting places – and also to try different food. In many countries, you can find really good food on the street.



HANOI, VIETNAM

The street food in Vietnam is **fantastic**. Banh mi is a meat and vegetable sandwich. They cover it with sauces: mayonnaise and spicy chili sauce. It's hot! You can also find great soup. I like pho bo. It has rice noodles and beef. You can have it for breakfast or dinner. The Vietnamese also make coffee with eggs. It's called *ca phe trung* and it's **unusual** but very **tasty**!

LIMA, PERU

The best street food in Peru is ceviche, the most famous dish. It's raw (uncooked) fish with limes, salt, and chili. People eat it with potatoes. I love it! You can also try causa, which is potato, vegetables, eggs, and chicken. Did you know there are 4,000 kinds of potatoes in Peru? Peruvians know lots of great ways to cook them.



NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA, USA

There are lots of food trucks on the streets of New Orleans. One of my favorites is the Cluck Truck. You can get **delicious** fried chicken with fries and waffles. There are many different sauces – make sure you try lots of them. I also like La Cocinita. They serve **fresh** Latin American food, and it's all good. I love their meat and cheese tacos with a very spicy sauce.
