Active	The subject does the action.	Lisa draws pictures every weekend.
Passive	The subject receives the action.	The pictures are drawn by Lisa every weekend.

	Form	Examples
(✓) Positive	Subject + am / is / are + V ₃	The crown is made of gold.
(X) Negative	Subject + am / is / are + not + V ₃	The crown is not made of gold.
(?) Question	Am / Is / Are + subject + V ₃ ... ?	Is the crown made of gold?
