	Meaning	Examples
<b>Active</b>	The subject <b>does</b> the action.	Lisa <b>draws</b> pictures every weekend.
<b>Passive</b>	The subject <b>receives</b> the action.	The pictures <b>are drawn</b> by Lisa every weekend.

	Form	Examples
<b>(✓) Positive</b>	Subject + am / is / are + V <sub>3</sub>	The crown <b>is made</b> of gold.
<b>(X) Negative</b>	Subject + am / is / are + not + V <sub>3</sub>	The crown <b>is not made</b> of gold.
<b>(?) Question</b>	Am / Is / Are + subject + V <sub>3</sub> ...?	<b>Is</b> the crown <b>made</b> of gold?
