### » Past: Was/Were

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I/He/She/It <b>was</b>	I/He/She/It <b>wasn't</b>	<b>Was</b> I/he/she/it...?
You/We/They <b>were</b>	You/We/They <b>weren't</b>	<b>Were</b> you/we/they...?
There <b>was</b> <b>were</b>	There <b>wasn't</b> <b>weren't</b>	<b>Was</b> there...? <b>Were</b> there...?

\* wasn't = was not    weren't = were not
