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Why the city of islands is my favorite city

What is your favorite city? Like many people, New York, London, Cape Town, and Sydney are all in my top ten. But what is my number one – my all-time favorite? Well, it's the Swedish city of Stockholm. Let me tell you why...

Stockholm is the capital city of Sweden and it has an amazing location. The city is on 14 different islands on a lake, by the sea. It's no surprise then, that 30% of this city is water. There are lots of parks and green spaces too – they make up another 30% of the city. For me, this is one of the special things about Stockholm – it's a busy and exciting city, but you can enjoy nature here too.

You can travel around Stockholm easily. It isn't a big city. Some tourists choose to take a boat from one island to another. But I think the best way to see the city is to walk around and enjoy the views. There are 57 bridges joining the different islands of Stockholm so this is easy to do. You should wear comfortable shoes, of course!

There's also a great subway system in Stockholm when you want to get somewhere quickly. But, there's another very good reason to use the subway... it's like a free art museum! Most of Stockholm's 100 subway stations decorate their walls with amazing paintings and other works of art.

Most tourists spend a lot of time on Djurgarden Island. This has many of Stockholm's famous museums. One of these is the Skansen museum, the world's oldest outdoor

museum. It is like being in a real-life history class. There are 150 historical buildings from all over Sweden. Some of them are from the 16th century.

You should visit Stockholm soon and experience its beautiful islands and of course enjoy its rich history and culture.
