REPORTED SPEECH

→ In reported speech, if the main verb is in the past, the rest of the sentence is usually past too:
E.g. Linda said (that) she was preparing for her exam.

→ If the reported words are 'always true', the tense does not change.
E.g. Nick told me he still likes you.

→ If a message is being reported immediately, the tense does not change.
E.g. Mary said she can't come.

If you say who somebody is talking to, use **tell**:

Bill **told me** that you were in Paris.
(not Bill said me)

Otherwise use **say**:

Bill said that you were in Paris.
(not Bill told that ...)

You can '**say** something **to** somebody':

Mary **said** goodbye **to** him and left.
(not Mary said him goodbye)
