Form:
→ to be + past participle (V3)

Tense	Form
Present Simple	am / is / are + V3
Present Continuous	am / is / are + being + V3
Past Simple	was / were + V3
Present Perfect	has / have + been + V3
Future Simple	will be + V3
Modal verbs (must, can/could, may/might, should, have to)	modal + be + V3

We use Passive Voice when:

- the action is more important than the person
- the person is unknown, obvious or not important
- we talk about rules, processes, news, facts
