My hero

My hero is Laura Dekker. She isn't a famous actor or singer. She **sailed** around the world **on her own** when she was 14 years old.

Laura was born when her parents were traveling around the world on the ocean. When she was young, Laura spent most of her life on a boat. She lived in a house for only one year of her early life.

She often helped her dad build boats. She built her first simple boat when she was six. From the age of eight, she earned money doing jobs like cleaning and **delivering** newspapers to people's
