Top tips for writers

None of us find writing easy. When you can't see the person who you're talking to, (20)(COMMUNICATE) is much more difficult. You have to be (21)(CARE) to communicate your message clearly.

The first thing you must think about is who you're writing to. Then you can make a (22)(DECIDE) about how formal it should be. A letter to a friend is more like spoken English, so your personality should be in your writing, while a letter to a hotel manager is formal.

The language in a story, for example, should be expressive, but the language in a report or an article should be much more (23) (INFORM). When you're writing a formal essay, make sure the (24)(INTRODUCE) gives a general idea of the subject. Later, in the (25)(CONCLUDE), you should summarise your opinion.
