SINGLE ROOM



All room, seats or spaces are already reserved, and nothing is available at that time.

SUITE



A room in a hotel designed for one person, it usually has one single bed.

PRICE



Refers to what you can see from a place, especially from a room, window, or location

FULLY-BOOKED



The amount of money you pay to buy something or to use a service.

VIEW



A large and comfortable hotel room that usually has more than one area, such as a bedroom and a living room

EN-SUITE



The process of registering at a hotel, airport, or event when you arrive, so you can begin using the service.

RECEPTION



The area or desk in a hotel, office, or building where guests are welcomed and helped

CHECK-IN



A hotel service where food, drinks, or other items are delivered directly to a guest's room

RECEPTIONIST



A bedroom has its own private bathroom, which is directly connected to the room

ROOM SERVICE



A person who welcomes guests, answers questions, and handles bookings or inquiries, usually at the front desk of a hotel, office, or building.
