A. THEORY

I. GRAMMAR REVISION

1. Comparative Adverbs (Trạng từ so sánh hơn)

- Trạng từ so sánh (comparative adverbs) được sử dụng để so sánh **cách một hành động được thực hiện giữa hai đối tượng hoặc hai sự việc.**

- Sau đây là quy tắc tạo trạng từ so sánh:

Loại trạng từ	Cách tạo dạng so sánh hơn	Ví dụ
Trạng từ ngắn (1 âm tiết)	- Thêm đuôi “-er” sau trạng từ - Trường hợp ngoại lệ “ early ”: đây là một trạng từ hoàn chỉnh có sẵn trong từ điển, -ly là một phần của từ gốc chứ không phải hậu tố được thêm vào từ tính từ, vì vậy early không thuộc nhóm trạng từ dài và vẫn được coi là trạng từ ngắn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> fast → faster: She runs faster than her brother. long → longer: The meeting lasted longer than expected. early → earlier: She arrived earlier than usual.
Trạng từ dài (≥ 2 âm tiết)	Dùng more hoặc less + trạng từ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> carefully → more carefully: He drives more carefully than I do. beautifully → less beautifully: She dances less beautifully than her sister.
Trạng từ bất quy tắc	Các trạng từ đặc biệt có dạng so sánh riêng	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> well → better: She sings better than I do. badly → worse: He dances worse than me. far → farther/further: I travel farther than him every year.

2. Compound noun (Danh từ ghép)

Định nghĩa	Phân loại
Danh từ ghép (compound nouns) là danh từ được tạo thành bằng cách ghép hai hoặc nhiều từ lại với nhau để tạo ra một nghĩa cụ thể. Chúng có thể được viết dưới ba dạng chính.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Danh từ ghép mở: giữa 2 từ có khoảng trống. <i>E.g.</i> heart attack (<i>đau tim</i>), post office, football field, swimming pool, etc. - Danh từ ghép nối: giữa các từ có dấu gạch nối. <i>E.g.</i> father-in-law (<i>bố vợ/ chồng</i>) - Danh từ ghép đóng: giữa 2 từ không có khoảng trống. <i>E.g.</i> toothpaste, applesauce (<i>nước sốt táo</i>), submarine (<i>tàu ngầm</i>) etc.

3. Abstract noun (Danh từ trừu tượng)

Định nghĩa	Phân loại
Danh từ trừu tượng (abstract nouns) là những danh từ chỉ ý tưởng, trạng thái, cảm xúc, hoặc các khái niệm mà chúng ta không thể nhìn thấy, sờ chạm hay đo lường được.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Danh từ chỉ cảm giác/cảm xúc. <i>E.g.</i> happiness Danh từ chỉ trạng thái. <i>E.g.</i> possibility (<i>tính khả thi</i>) Danh từ chỉ đặc điểm tính cách. <i>E.g.</i> honesty (<i>sự trung thực</i>) Danh từ chỉ khái niệm. <i>E.g.</i> freedom (<i>sự tự do</i>) Danh từ chỉ sự kiện. <i>E.g.</i> birthday

- Thông thường, các danh từ trừu tượng được tạo thành từ **danh từ, động từ hoặc tính từ** + hậu tố. Dưới đây là một số ví dụ:
