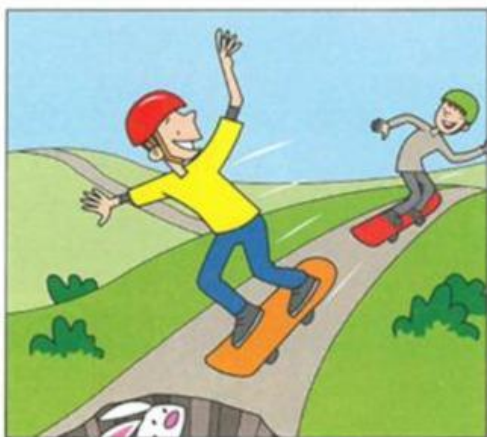

❖ **Step 1:** Look at the pictures.

- **Body:** Say what happens in the story: next, after that, then, finally/in the end.
- **Ending:** Talk about how the story ends and how the people feel.

❖ **Step 3:** How should it look?

- Write the number of the picture you are describing and then write your sentences.

**Example:**

**Picture 1:** One day an astronaut is arriving on a strange planet/the moon.
