How to talk about jobs:

We use:

- **Verb to be** → to say **what** a person **is**
- **Present Simple** → to say **what** a person **does** and **where** they work

Structure:

He / She is + a / an + job ----- **they are + job (s)**

He / She + verb + S(present simple) ----- **they + verb (present simple)**



Doctor:

She **is** a doctor.
She **works** in a hospital.
She **helps** sick people and **gives** medicine.

Teacher:

She **is** a teacher.
She **works** in a school.
She **teaches** students and **explains** lessons.
