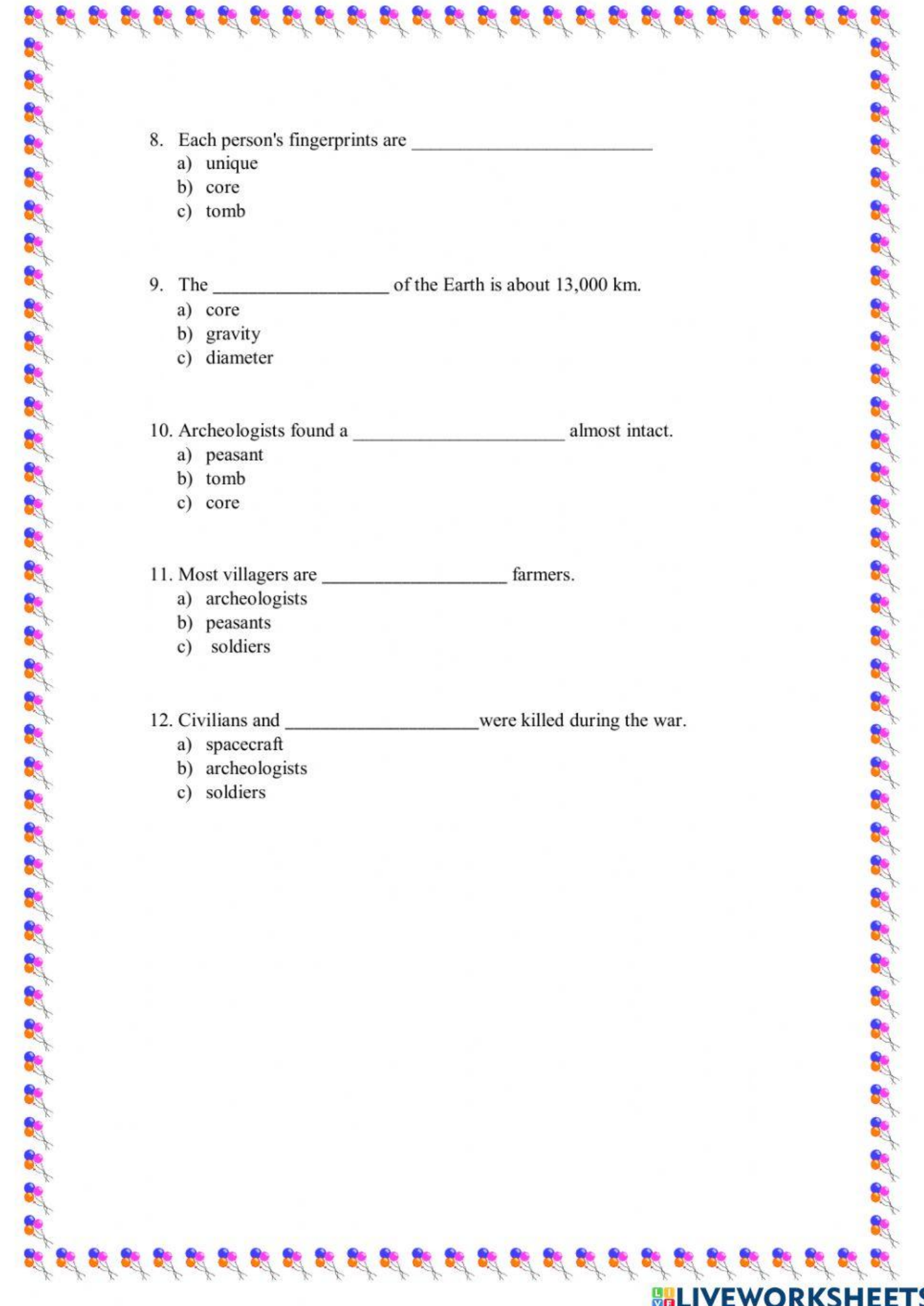

At night, the Earth stays warm because its atmosphere keeps the heat in. We think other planets are too hot or too cold for things to grow. On earth, we have fertile ground, water and plants. This makes it possible for animals and people to live on the earth. Mercury is one of the planets in our solar system. It is closest to the Sun. The Sun makes it very hot during the day. There is almost no atmosphere on Mercury to keep in the heat. So, at night it is very cold because the heat escapes from the planet. Mercury has a hard, rocky surface. It is too hot for plants, animals, or people to live on Mercury.
