1. Review: Past Simple (Thì quá khứ đơn)

Cấu trúc		Với động từ "to be"	Với động từ thường
	Khẳng định	S + was/were + N/Adj	S + V2/V-ed (+ O)
	Phủ định	S + was/were + not + N/Adj	S + didn't + V-inf (+ O)
Cách dùng	+ Cho những hành động xảy ra và đã kết thúc trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> He sold his car two weeks ago. + Để thể hiện thói quen hay một điều đã từng đúng trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> When he was young, he lived in a small flat. + Cho những hành động xảy ra nối tiếp nhau trong quá khứ. <i>E.g.</i> She put on her coat, took her bag and left the house.		
Dấu hiệu nhận biết	yesterday; last week/month/year; khoảng thời gian + ago; in + mốc thời gian ở quá khứ, etc.

2. Past Continuous (Quá khứ tiếp diễn)

a. Cấu trúc:

Loại câu	Cấu trúc	Ví dụ
Khẳng định	S + was/were + V _{ing} .	She was planting trees at 4 p.m. yesterday.
Phủ định	S + wasn't/weren't + V _{ing} .	They weren't working for that company at that time in 1990.
Nghi vấn	Was/Were + S + V _{ing} ? ➤ Yes, S + was/were. ➤ No, S + wasn't/weren't.	Was he eating while I was studying ? – No, he was not.
Wh-question	Wh- + was/were + S + V _{ing} ?	Where was he learning at 8 p.m. yesterday?

b. Cách dùng:

- Diễn tả một hành động hoặc sự việc xảy ra tại một thời điểm xác định trong quá khứ.
Ví dụ: At **9 p.m yesterday**, my family **was watching** TV.
- Diễn tả hai hay nhiều hành động đang xảy ra đồng thời trong quá khứ.
Ví dụ: At **9 p.m yesterday**, I **was driving** while my brother **was singing**.
- Diễn tả một hoạt động đang diễn ra thì bất chợt có hành động khác xen vào.
Ví dụ: When Jane came, we **were having** dinner.

III. METHOD

STEP 1: ĐỌC LƯỢT & QUÉT THÔNG TIN (Skim & Scan)

Skimming = Đọc nhanh để hiểu ý chính của cả đoạn.

Scanning = Nhìn nhanh để tìm thông tin cụ thể/từ khóa cần thiết cho đáp án.

Ví dụ: Câu hỏi 1

ĐỌC LƯỢT – SKIMMING (lấy ý chính): Sandra đang học làm tóc + trang điểm, muốn làm tình nguyện để lấy kinh nghiệm làm việc, thích làm việc nhóm, thích tiếp xúc với khách hàng.

Nhận định ban đầu (sau khi skim):

→ Công việc **liên quan đến làm đẹp / hair / beauty**

→ **KHÔNG cần lương** (volunteer)

→ Có **khách hàng**, làm việc **theo nhóm**

→ Phù hợp môi trường **dịch vụ – tiếp tân – salon**

QUÉT – SCANNING (tìm nhanh mỗi khớp đáp án)

Từ khóa cần scan trong mô tả công việc: **volunteer; hair / beauty; customers; reception; work experience; team**

SCAN CÁC JOB A–H (đối chiếu nhanh)

Job C – *Susie's Hairdressing*

*We are a new hairdresser's and we want a young, hard-working **volunteer** to manage our reception desk. You will take calls, make bookings and help build a relationship with our **customers**.*

KẾT LUẬN – CHỐT ĐÁP ÁN C (Susie's Hairdressing)

STEP 2: LOẠI TRỪ ĐÁP ÁN (Answer elimination)

Mục tiêu: Giúp học sinh **loại đáp án sai trước**, tránh đọc lại cả bài nhiều lần và **không bị bẫy từ giống nhau**.

♦ **BƯỚC 1: Đọc CÂU HỎI trước – không đọc đáp án ngay**

✓ Gạch chân:

- từ để hỏi (who / why / what / where / when / how)
- từ khóa nội dung (hành động, lý do, cảm xúc, thời gian)

✎ Xác định câu hỏi đang hỏi **THÔNG TIN GÌ?** (lý do / kết quả / chi tiết / ý chính)

♦ **BƯỚC 2: Đọc đoạn văn và LOẠI đáp án sai**

Kiểu đáp án sai thường gặp

- Đáp án có từ giống bài nhưng sai ý
- Đáp án đúng một phần, nhưng thiếu thông tin chính
- Đáp án bị phủ định trong bài
- Đáp án suy luận logic nhưng **KHÔNG** có trong bài
- Đáp án sai thời điểm / sai đối tượng

♦ **BƯỚC 3: Chọn đáp án còn lại PHÙ HỢP NHẤT**

✓ Đáp án đúng thường:

- được **paraphrase** (viết lại bằng từ khác)
- xuất hiện **gần từ khóa**
- không quá chi tiết**, cũng **không quá chung**

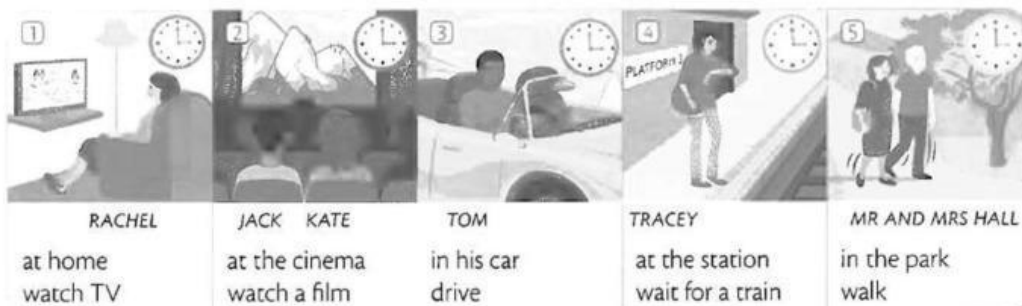
