## LOCATION

- The physical position of people and places on Earth's surface
- Location can be absolute, or exact, or it can be relative to other places

## PLACE

- A location's distinct physical and human characteristics
- Over time, places can change due to human action and natural factors like erosion and climate

## REGION

- A group of places that share distinct and unique characteristics
- Shared characteristics can be human, natural, or both

## MOVEMENT

- The movement of people, goods, and ideas between places
- Relationships between people and places are shaped by movement and migration

## HUMAN-ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION

- The relationship between humans and their environment
- Humans depend on, adapt to, and modify their environment
