Compare these sentences:

+ Affirmative: I **will** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **will not** be ready in five minutes.

– Negative: I **won't** be ready in five minutes.

+ Affirmative: She **will** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **will not** arrive on time.

– Negative: She **won't** arrive on time.



In spoken English, the contraction **WON'T** is used more.

I	will	→	I	will not	=	I	won't
You	will	→	You	will not	=	You	won't
He	will	→	He	will not	=	He	won't
She	will	→	She	will not	=	She	won't
It	will	→	It	will not	=	It	won't
We	will	→	We	will not	=	We	won't
They	will	→	They	will not	=	They	won't
