Types of Adjectives



Descriptive Adjectives	Describe the qualities or characteristics of nouns. Eg: Beautiful, tall	Interrogative Adjectives	Used in questions to ask about a specific noun. Eg: Which, Whose
Proper Adjectives	Proper nouns and are used to specify a particular person, place, or thing eg: italian, bollywood	Exclamatory Adjectives	Express strong emotions or feelings Eg: Wonderful, amazing
Demonstrative Adjectives	Points out specific nouns and answers the question. Eg: This, That, those, these	Attributive adjectives	Is a word that describes a noun, providing more information about it. Eg: red car, starry night
Quantitative Adjectives	Provides information about the quantity or number of nouns. Eg: Three, enough	Participial adjectives	Formed from verbs, often ending in "-ing" or "-ed," to describe a noun's effect.. Eg: exciting, frightened
Possessive Adjectives	Show ownership or possession of a noun. Eg: My, Mine, her, their	Predicate adjectives	Follow linking verbs to describe the subject of a sentence. Eg: delicious, beautiful
