- **Plane** - an aircraft for traveling long distances through the air
- **Cable car** - a vehicle pulled by a cable up steep hills
- **Bus** - a large vehicle for carrying many passengers on roads
- **Train** - a vehicle with connected cars running on railway tracks
- **Ferry** - a boat that carries passengers and vehicles across water
