



# RELATIVE CLAUSES



In English we can find two types of relative clauses depending on the information we are giving. These can also be combined with tenses.



Relative clauses that give necessary information (no commas):

*The artist **who won the award** gave an emotional speech.*

*The movie **that broke records** was released last month.*



Relative clauses that give extra information (use commas):

*Taylor Swift, **who is known for her songwriting**, announced a world tour.*

*The Grammys, **which take place every year**, celebrate the best in music.*
