Task 3: Read the text**HOBBIES**

While hobbies are often seen as a way to relax, they can also play an important role in shaping a person's character. Many young people choose hobbies that challenge them, require long-term commitment, and sometimes even cause stress. However, these challenges can help them learn valuable life skills.

Minh, an 18-year-old high school student, has a hobby that surprises many people: restoring old bicycles. He became interested in this activity after finding a broken bike in his grandfather's garage. Instead of throwing it away, Minh decided to fix it. At first, he had very little knowledge about bicycle mechanics and often made mistakes. He spent hours searching for information online and asking experienced people for advice.

Restoring bicycles is not always enjoyable. Minh admits that it can be frustrating when parts are difficult to find or repairs take longer than expected. Nevertheless, he continues because the process teaches him patience and problem-solving skills. He also enjoys the feeling of achievement when a bicycle finally works again.

Although Minh usually works alone, he sometimes sells restored bicycles at local markets. This has helped him improve his communication skills and manage money more carefully. His parents were worried at first that this hobby would distract him from his studies, but they have changed their opinion after seeing how organised he has become. Minh does not plan to turn his hobby into a full-time job. Instead, he believes it has prepared him for adult life by teaching him responsibility and independence.
