

Warm- up: Irregular Verbs

Verbs are *action* words.



LIVEWORKSHEETS

Most verbs follow the rule of adding **-ed** for past tense.

Examples:

jump > jumped

kick > kicked

stop > stopped

These are called **regular verbs**.

Some verbs **do not** follow the rule of adding **-ed**.

shake > shook

lose > lost

take > took

These are called **irregular verbs**.

Can I shake your hand?

He throw 23 balls at the game last night.

I wake up this morning at 7:30 AM.

Irregular Verbs Examples

Present (now)	Past (yesterday)
draw	drew
feel	felt
fly	flew
forget	forgot

Target Irregular Verbs

Present	Past
sleep	slept
read	read
sing	sang
swim	swam
tell	told
send	sent
throw	threw
wake	woke
win	won
cost	cost

Present	Past
pay	paid
read	read
sell	sold
send	sent
teach	taught
spend	spent
