**e.g.** The computer technicians **are in for** a long day at work because they have to upgrade all the company's computers.

**be off (phr v):** to go away from a place

**e.g.** It's 8am and I must **be off** otherwise I'll be late for work.

**be on (phr v):** (of a film, show, etc) to be on TV

**e.g.** My favourite science and technology documentary **is on** at 9pm tonight.

**be out of (phr v):** to have no more of sth

**e.g.** I can't print my project because the printer **is out of** ink.
