

# Modals of Probability



## Grammar Reference

**Must + verb:** використовуємо, коли ми впевнені, що щось є правдою (**high certainty**).

**Might / Could + verb:** використовуємо, коли ми думаємо, що щось можливо (**possibility**).

**Can't + verb:** використовуємо, коли ми впевнені, що щось неможливо (**NOT mustn't**)

2. Look at that animal. It has a sweet face, but it could / can't be a golden poison dart frog – those are only found in South America.

6. He looks very confused. He must / can't understand the homework.
