

## PAST SIMPLE

Se utiliza cuando la acción **terminó** y **empezó** en un momento específico

Formación:

- **Afirmativa** → sujeto + verbo en pasado
  - verbo regular en -ed
  - verbo irregular 2º columna
- **Negativa** → sujeto + **didn't** + verbo en presente
- **Interrogativa** → **Did** + sujeto + verbo en presente

## PAST CONTINUOUS

Se utiliza para **acciones que estaban ocurriendo** en un momento dado

Formación:

- **Afirmativa** → sujeto + **was/were** + verbo -ing
- **Negativa** → sujeto + **wasn't/weren't** + verbo -ing
- **Interrogativa** → **was/were** + sujeto + verbo -ing
