PAST SIMPLE

Se utiliza cuando la acción **terminó** y **empezó** en un momento específico

Formación:

- **Afirmativa** → sujeto + **verbo en pasado** 
- **Negativa** → sujeto + **didn't** + **verbo en presente**
- **Interrogativa** → **Did** + sujeto + **verbo en presente**

PAST CONTINUOUS

Se utiliza para **acciones que estaban ocurriendo** en un momento dado

Formación:

- **Afirmativa** → sujeto + **was/were** + **verbo -ing**
- **Negativa** → sujeto + **wasn't/weren't** + **verbo -ing**
- **Interrogativa** → **was/were** + sujeto + **verbo -ing**
